Algerian press reported on 31 March 2019 that Ali Haddad was arrested on the Algerian border with Tunisia during an attempt to escape to Tunisia. Ali Haddad is an Algerian Businessman. He is the co-founder and CEO of ETRHB (*Entreprise des Travaux Routiers, Hydrauliques et Bâtiments*) and the President of the FCE (*Forum des Chefs d'Entreprises*) since 2014. According to Forbes, the global media company, **he** is one of the richest men in Algeria.

Haddad is accused of fraud and many financial crimes including bribery and using the influence of senior members of Bouteflika government. The Prosecutor General launched investigations into corruption and the illicit transfer of capital abroad. Similarly, an investigation into corruption against Ali Haddad, according to the same sources, was entrusted to the research brigade of the National Gendarmerie of Bab J'did, Algiers. It is worth mentioning that Haddad was apprehended in possession of three passports **that** were obtained illegally with the complicity of the Daira of Bir Mourad Rais.
